

CCBU no BRAZIL ON THE BEACH

O Centro Cultural coordenou a tenda cultural no mega evento Brazil On The Beach, organizado pela Cidade de Hollywood e a Rhythm Foundation, nos dias 20, 21 e 22 de março. A música brasileira, competições de futevôlei, apresentações de percussionistas, de capoeira e maculelê, filmes, e comida típica tomaram conta do animado calçadão da praia de Hollywood.

Na tenda cultural, cujo tema era a Bahia, decorada com uma manequim vestida de baiana e um altar para lemanjá, o CCBU apresentou filmes sobre aspectos culturais baianos e apresentações do babalorixá Carlinhos Encarnação, ofereceu doces e comidinhas típicas da ABCatering, e colocou a venda artigos de artesanato e livros em português. Dividimos a tenda com o Consulado Geral do Brasil, representado por Lourdes Herczeg do Setor Cultural, com as representantes do Brazilian Film Festival.

Depois de um sábado com muita chuva e vento, os participantes do festival aproveitaram o domingo ensolarado e os três dias de Brasil na praia de Hollywood encerraram-se com um sensacional concerto da diva brasileira Daniela Mercury.

Gene de Souza, da Rhythm Foundation, e um dos organizadores, estava extático com o sucesso do evento e informou que "os números oficiais da polícia de Hollywood foram: sessenta e cinco mil pessoas nos três dias do festival, trinta e cinco mil, no domingo apenas e dez mil no show de Daniela Mercury. Foi o maior evento da história de Hollywood."



CCBU AT BRAZIL ON THE BEACH

The Cultural Center coordinated the cultural tent at the mega event BRAZIL ON THE BEACH, organized by the City of Hollywood and Rhythm Foundation, March 20, 21 and 22. Brazilian music, foot volley competitions, percussionists workshops, capoeira and maculelê presentations, films and typical food took over the lively Broadwalk on the Hollywood beach.

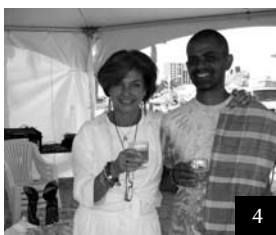

Encarnação. The CCBU also offered typical sweets and snacks by ABCatering and sold many handicrafts and Brazilian books. We shared the tent with the Consulate General of Brazil and Brazilian Film Festival representatives.

After a lot of rain and wind on Saturday, festival goers enjoyed a gorgeous sunny Sunday and the three days of Brazil on the Hollywood Beach closed with a sensational concert by Brazilian diva Daniela Mercury.

Gene de Souza, from Rhythm Foundation and one of the organizers was ecstatic with the success of the event and informed that the "official numbers of the Hollywood Police were: 65 thousand people during the three festival days, 35 thousand Sunday only and 10 thousand at Daniela Mercury's show. It was the biggest event in Hollywood's history."
